FSUSD – Nicole Smith reported they are down 20 teachers, which are all being covered by long-term subs. All service provider positions are filled except for one Occupational Therapist Assistant. FSUSD has contracted paraeducators for H. Glenn and 1:1 student aides. FSUSD is launching two new Program for Emotional Regulation and Learning (PERL) classes at Cleo Gordon.

North Bay Regional Center (NBRC) – Deborah Simms provided flyers in three different languages for their Parent Reunion event.

Independent Child Advocate – Dr. Amber Busay's presentation covered a lot of what she has been helping parents with. The majority of it being what to do before and after an IEP.

6.2 Assistant Superintendents Report- Andrew Ownby reported that Matrix Parent Network has kicked off its parent workshops. Solano SELPA attended the Back to School Fair at St. Mark's in Fairfield. SELPA started the year by hosting their 5th annual 3-day conference, "Under the Big Top." Andrew gave an update on the California bills and Supreme Court cases affecting special education.
