6.1. Representative Reports

BUSD - Absent

DUSD – No Report

FSUSD – Nicole Smith reported Fairfield-Suisun's second CAC parent representative is going forward for FSUSD Board approval at the next meeting. FSUSD has open positions that include teachers for TAP and SCIL, paraeducators, and various service providers.

TUSD — Kristie Ballard reported Travis is still trying to fill teacher positions and one psych position. Their board just approved for TUSD to explore the impact of changing to a 6th-8th grade middle school model. They have set the date for their Special Olympics. It will be held April 30, 2024.

VUSD – Aumrey Moland reported that Vacaville has spent the last few weeks setting its goals for staff and service providers. One of the goals is to look at how they can best support their students in special education and their families post-Covid. One program they are looking at is the Transitional Academics Program (TAP). They are looking at alternative models and finding ways to include more inclusion opportunities. VUSD Special Education department has been working with their Ed Services department (Gen Ed) and have used a portion of their state grant to support all their teachers in using inclusion practices.

SCOE - Absent

North Bay Regional Center (NBRC) – Emily Koehler reported they will be hosting a Trunk or Treat on October 31st from 4-6 p.m.

Independent Child Advocate – Dr. Amber Busay reported that in September, she had 17 new referrals, which put her caseload a little over 40. She expects October to double that number, as she is getting between 5-10 weekly. Amber has been working with parents to help them understand the IEP process and helping to resolve any disputes with the districts or site levels. She and one of the SELPA Coordinators will do a parent night in the spring. It will be presented both in person and virtually.

6.2 Assistant Superintendents Report- Andrew Ownby gave an update on the California bills and the Emma C. case affecting special education.
