**FSUSD** – Teresa Ureste reported that the Fairfield-Suisun USD is navigating the recent shift to the purple tier which will cause new guidelines for small group instruction, however new assessments will continue in person with the PPE guidelines.

**TUSD** – Holly DeShazo reported on behalf of the Travis USD that the district is still in distance learning for all students and is doing in person assessments. Travis held a special education collaboration yesterday with elementary and preschool staff which Holly facilitated. The staff had a large list of things that are going well during distance learning. Holly recently attended two STOMP trainings which is specialized training of military parents which was open to parents in California, Arizona, and Nevada. Topics included the IEP process.

**VUSD** – Monica reported that the Vacaville USD Special Education K-2<sup>nd</sup> grade has returned to in person instruction. The district has purchased a Dyslexia curriculum, in addition to new Math and English curriculums. Vacaville has submitted their special education targeted review to the SELPA. The district is looking forward to January to start their parent education meetings again.

**SCOE** – Tonya reported for SCOE that they are collaborating with the districts within the Solano County Office of Education. SCOE is doing a combination of distance learning and small group cohort instruction.

**Matrix Parent Network** – Margaret Johnson reported for Matrix that they agency is continuing to offer virtual trainings. Matrix is trying to put all their trainings online on their website and YouTube to further reach parents in need of help. Matrix will be reaching out to an additional 11 counties soon to provide further information to parents in those counties. Matrix continues to answer calls to their help line and offer one to one consultation to parents.
