Matrix has hired Sydney Gray, a parent of a child with special needs and a spouse who is stationed at Travis Air Force Base as their Military Outreach Coordinator.

DUSD – No Representative

FSUSD – Steve Phillips reported on behalf of the Fairfield-Suisun USD, noting that the district is preparing for extended school year which will consist of four hours per day, five days a week of in person instruction. The district has several open positions to fill for the 2021-2022 school year.

TUSD – Kristin Ballard reported on behalf of the Travis USD that the district is also in the process of preparing for extended school year. Travis USD has several positions to be filled for the 2021-22 school year.

VUSD – Angel Hixson reported for VUSD that the district is piloting an inclusion-based TAP class at Hemlock Elementary for the 2021-22 school year. Vacaville USD also has several open positions for the 2021-22 school year. Vacaville is currently working on preparing for the end of the year and Senior graduations.

SCOE – Tonya Roschen reported on behalf of the Solano County Office of Education (SCOE) that on June 2nd SCOE will be holding their adult completion ceremony. Teachers are preparing for extended school year and beginning the preparations for in person instruction for the 2021-22 school year. SCOE has created a new event called Solano Quest Explorer which is an outdoor treasure hunt at Lagoon Valley. Details can be found on the SCOE website.

North Bay Regional Center (NBRC) – Deborah Simms reported for North Bay Regional Center that staff continues to work remotely and expect to be back in the office in July using a hybrid model. They are currently holding in person meetings for individuals in group home settings or supported living settings. They are currently serving all other clients via zoom or telephone. NBRC has Self Determination programs open to any regional center client effective June 7th.

Assistant Superintendent's Report - Andrew Ownby presented an update of the SELPA's latest developments; highlighting professional development offerings, current legislation related to special education, and CDE compliance and monitoring support the SELPA provides its member districts.
