5.1. Representative Reports

BUSD – Erin Biber reported that the Benicia USD has a new director, Steve Phillips, who has been holding parent forums to address concerns.

DUSD – No Representative

FSUSD – Nicole Rabbani reported for the Fairfield-Suisun USD that the district is working to fill para-educator vacancies. IEP needs are being met by case managers. Behaviorists are dealing with increased behaviors and Mental Health Clinicians have been involved with increased requests for initial assessments.

TUSD – Kristie Ballard reported for the Travis USD that they continue to battle with a para-educator shortage. The district's Special Olympics program will be back in April of 2023. Travis is working on administrative changes across the district.

VUSD – Monica Hurtado reported for VUSD that the preschool hosted their first parent night. This is the first of a series of parent collaboration opportunities. At Vacaville High the district has a student with special needs that volunteers as an assistant after school. In a recent scrimmage game, the freshmen team put him on the field and worked with the opposing team to orchestrate his first touchdown. Included was a short clip showing this event. The Vacaville school district will be hosting a job fair on October 22 at Markham Elementary from 9:00 AM to 1:00 PM.

SCOE – Ilah Feeney reported for the Solano County Office of Education (SCOE) that the Inclusion Film Premier will be held tonight at Touro University. SCOE will also be having a Harvest Festival at Larsen.

North Bay Regional Center (NBRC) – Tobias Weare reported on North Bay's behalf that the Regional Center is hosting a series of quarterly community conversations via Zoom and in person. The first Zoom meeting will be on October 19th and the first in person meeting is October 26th at the Vacaville Cultural Center Library. Flyers were distributed at the meeting with details.
