FSUSD – Nicole Rabbani reported for the Fairfield-Suisun USD that the district recently went through a review during the 2nd week of September from FCNT, who were brought in to look at two specific areas of concern, service provider staffing and the overall structure of the special education department. Interviews with staff were conducted and they are waiting for the results of this review. The district is still in need of para-educators and other staff. Fairfield-Suisun has nominated a parent representative for the CAC and are awaiting board approval.

TUSD – Kristie Ballard reported for the Travis USD that they have several positions available they are looking to fill. The district has two new TAP programs at Foxboro Elementary.

VUSD – Monica Hurtado reported for VUSD that a growing trend not only in California, but nationwide, is a pivot to virtual speech instruction. VUSD has partnered with several agencies to provide speech service for students. Students will receive support and supervision while participating in their speech sessions while at school. VUSD preschool received a sizable grant from the state and will be expanding programs and services for their youngest learners. The preschool is also hosting family informational nights coming soon with details being

provided directly to the families currently served in the program. Staffing continues to be a challenge. VUSD will be hosting a job fair on October 22 at Markham Elementary for classified staff and substitute teachers.

SCOE – Ilah Feeney reported for the Solano County Office of Education (SCOE) that on October 11th TC McDaniel will have a back to school night. The DHH program will have a virtual parent night on October 19th. And the Inclusion Film Premiere will be at Touro University on October 20th. SCOE continues to recruit and hire new staff.
