

W. Catastrophic Costs

W1. Purpose

It is the intent of the Solano SELPA to assist member LEAs against catastrophic costs associated with the implementation of regionalized services included within the SELPA's delivery model. Should a district experience an unexpected cost, related to regionalized services, the districts may apply to the SELPA for relief.

A catastrophic cost is considered an unbudgeted, one-time cost, incurred as a result of factors deemed outside the control of the LEA and is related to the implementation of regionalized services included within the SELPA's delivery model.

W2. Administration

Member LEAs may submit written request for catastrophic relief to the Assistant Superintendent, SELPA. This request shall include the nature of the problem, including relevant historical information; a statement of current need; and projections for the subsequent fiscal year. The Assistant Superintendent, SELPA, meets with the LEA Superintendent and CBO to clarify and evaluate the request, as appropriate. The Assistant Superintendent, SELPA, will place the request for catastrophic relief on the next available meeting of the Council of Superintendents.
