## SELPA Partnerships

Solano County SELPA is proud to maintain partnerships with multiple agencies to ensure we coordinate services for students in our community.

Annually, the SELPA reviews and executes agreements with the Vallejo SELPA and North Bay Regional Center to ensure a cooperative working relationship with both infant/toddler and school-age services. Additionally, the SELPA maintains agreements with Matrix Parent Network for the coordination of parent supports, and Child Start Inc., for coordination of services with the local Head Start provider. Lastly, we maintain an agreement with seven SELPAs and their member districts (59 LEAs in all!) for students to access the Regional Deaf Hard-of-Hearing programs.
