State Monitoring of Special Education

Twenty-six (26) years ago in November, a group of students with disabilities filed a class-action lawsuit against their school district and the CDE. While the case against the district was ultimately resolved, the case against the state regarding its failure to monitor the implementation of the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA) continues. To address the two of the findings made by Judge Vince Chhabria, CDE will be implementing two new monitoring systems this year:

IEP Implementation

Each district will receive a list of students (10% of the total count of students with disabilities) to analyze and submit "the percent of IEP services delivered" during a specific time frame. The data will be entered online. Ten Percent of those students will be selected for audit, and backup documentation will be required. Be sure to keep records of your special education services!

Small LEA Monitoring

Beginning in 22-23, charter schools, considered small LEAs if they serve less than 100 SWD, will be selected every three years for in-depth monitoring, including file reviews, education benefit reviews, and policy and procedure reviews.
