Input Needed for the Solano SELPA Local Plan

Special Education Local Plan Areas (SELPA's) were created in California in the 1970s to coordinate activities related to special education for each local area or region of the state. One of the primary activities of a SELPA is to ensure the availability of a continuum of services is developed in each region to provide eligible students with disabilities with a free, appropriate public education (FAPE).

In June of 2018, the Governor signed into law Assembly Bill 1808, which, among other things, requires all Special Education Local Plan Areas to review and update the Local Plan.
