Legislation Update

The deadline to introduce bills has passed and we have a good sense of what is pending that may impact special education this year. In addition to the two year bills noted in the <u>February</u> <u>newsletter</u>:

AB-2173 (Portantino) This bill seeks to replace the term "Emotional Disturbance" with "Emotional Disability" in California laws.

AB-2026 (Mathis) This bill makes changes implement person-first language in various existing laws.

AB-1938 (Gallagher) This bill would require that, for students with hearing and/or vision impairments, inclusive practices means placement that provides full access to the language or specialized services the pupil requires.
